



The main objective of the Society for Old Age Rational Suicide (SOARS), founded in Brighton and Hove in 2009, on December 10 (Human Rights Day), is to change UK law so that very elderly, mentally competent individuals, who are suffering unbearably from various health problems (although none of them is "terminal") are legally allowed to receive a doctor's assistance to die, if this is their persistent request.

Generally, public opinion agrees with this objective. Two ICM polls were commissioned by SOARS in 2010: one, in February, was of 1,000 adults in Brighton and Hove; the other, in July, was of 1,009 adults throughout the UK. Both showed that 67% of those polled were in support, with only 18% and 19% respectively opposed, and the others were uncertain.
